



Lost Children Policy and Procedure

At Mountpanther Farm Park we aim to ensure that every child is safe and secure in all the services that we provide. Highlighted below are the measures that we take to prevent a child in the Farm Park getting lost.

Although it is a requirement that you always supervise your children, we do realise that they can slip away from you in a moment. If this happens, please do not panic but alert a staff member of Mountpanther Farm Park as quickly as possible and we will carry out a structured search of the site for you. Stay as close to where you last saw them.

The Farm Park will use the pre-planned route to help locate the missing child.

Teach your child, if they are lost

- Stop, stand still & look, don't run about
- If you see the person you were with, go to them and hold their hand
- Look for a member of Mountpanther Farm Park wearing a blue t-shirt or fleece.
- Tell them not to go up to anyone else.

The best way to help a lost child is to try and prevent it happening in the first place and take precautions to help if it does.

- Encourage children to stay close to you
- Use reins or wrist links
- Don't leave a child in an unsupervised play area
- Make a note of what your child is wearing
